### ELIGIBILITY:

- 1) Must be enrolled or be accepted and have plans to attend Texas Tech University as a full time student for the 2012-2013 school year.
- 2) Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or better.
- 3) Must be actively involved in your local Catholic Community or the Catholic Community at Texas Tech.

### RESTRICTIONS:

The Board of Directors, Officers and scholarship committee members of Chi Rho Associations, Inc., and their family members, are excluded from competition.
